Can I Vote Early?

All Arizonans can vote by mail, or early in person at a polling place in their county.

Early In-Person Voting Period
October 12—November 4

Request an absentee ballot by
October 28

What ID Do I Need to Vote?

You must show ID when voting early in person or on Election Day.

Voters can show one form of ID with name, address, and photo (List 1); or two forms of non-photo ID with just the name and address (List 2); or a List 1 photo ID with a non-matching address or a U.S. passport or military ID without an address plus a List 2 non-photo ID with a matching address.

- List 1 photo IDs include: an Arizona driver's license or ID card; tribal ID or enrollment card; or other valid U.S. federal, state, or local government-issued identification.
- List 2 non-photo IDs include: a voter registration card; utility bill; bank statement; Arizona vehicle registration; Arizona vehicle insurance card; other valid federal, state, or local government ID; and any "Official Election Material" mail.
- **Student IDs are NOT acceptable forms of ID.**
