Can I vote early?

Any Illinois voter may request an absentee mail ballot or vote early or absentee in-person before Election Day.

Contact your local election authority for early voting times and locations.

Early Voting Period

September 29 - November 7

Request an Absentee Ballot by

November 3 (by mail)

November 7 (in person)

What ID do I need to register?

By mail or online

The voter registration form requires an Illinois driver's license or ID number, or the last four digits of your Social Security Number.

Register by mail by: October 11

Register online by: October 23

In-person

You can register in-person through Election Day. Two forms of ID, with at least one showing your current address, are needed to register in-person. Examples include: driver's license, social security card, utility bill, student ID, or credit card.
