Election Day is November 8

Can I Vote Early?

- You must have an excuse to vote absentee-by-mail (disability, illness, work, etc.) For a full list of excuses visit indianavoters.in.gov.
- All voters can vote early by absentee-in-person at your county board of elections from October 12 to November 7.

What ID Do I Need to Vote?

All voters must show ID. The ID must:

- Display your photo
- Display your name (it must conform to your voter registration record).
- Have an expiration date and either be current or have expired sometime after the date of the last general election (November 4, 2014)
- Be issued by the State of Indiana or the U.S. government

Student IDs from Indiana state schools can be used if it meets all four criteria specified above. A student ID from a private school can't be used.
