What ID do I need to vote?

If you are registering to vote on Election Day you must show proof of identity and residence at the polls. This includes:

- Iowa driver's license or state ID
- U.S. passport
- Iowa college or high school student ID (with expiration date)
- Military ID (with expiration date)

If your photo ID doesn't have a current Iowa address you must show a lease, utility bill, bank statement or paycheck with your current address.
