You can Register and Vote on Election Day: November 8

What ID Do I Need to Register?

Everyone who registers to vote must show a photo ID or complete a qualified voter affidavit. IDs include:

- Driver's license or other New Hampshire ID from the DMV
- Military ID card
- Other ID card from the federal, state, county, or municipal government
- Valid student ID card
- Utility bill, bank statement

If you can't register in person you may request an absentee form from your town clerk or the Secretary of State. Include proof of identity and domicile. An absentee registration form must be witnessed.

Can I vote early?

- You must provide a reason for voting absentee. You must be out of town on Election Day or unable to vote in person due to a disability, religious observance, or work obligation.
- Completed absentee ballots must be returned before 5 p.m. November 7.

What ID Do I Need to Vote?

Voters must show photo ID or complete a challenged voter affidavit to vote. IDs include a driver's license, US military ID, US passport, or a valid student ID card. Individuals without one of the above approved forms of ID may still cast a ballot if they complete a challenged voter affidavit.
