## Register to Vote by October 10

## Election Day is November 6

### Can I Vote Early?

Missouri voters need an excuse to vote by mail such as being out of the county on Election Day or illness.

#### **Request a mail ballot by:**

5 p.m. October 31

#### **Vote absentee in-person up to**

5 p.m. on November 5

#### **Completed ballots must be received by the county election authority by:**

7 p.m. November 6

First-time voters who registered by mail must submit a copy of an ID when they request a mail ballot.

### What ID Do I Need to Vote

Missouri voters voting in person must show ID to vote a regular ballot. Show one of these:

- Missouri license or state ID
- Passport
- Military photo ID

OR show one of these and sign an affirmation statement:

- ID from Missouri college, university, vocational, or technical school
- current utility bill, paycheck or bank statement
- voter registration card
- other government document with name and address

If you don't have ID, you can cast a provisional ballot if your signature matches your voter registration file.
