What kind of photo ID do I need to vote?

- Georgia driver's license
- Student ID cards from most public and technical institutions.
- *Private* university students must show one of the other acceptable forms of photo ID to vote
- Valid state or federal issued photo
- ID, including a Voter ID Card issued by your county registrar's office or by Georgia Department of Driver Services (DDS)
- Valid U.S. passport
- Valid U.S. military photo ID, or
- Valid tribal photo ID

You Can Vote Early: Absentee by Mail or Absentee by Mail

- You don't need an excuse to vote absentee by mail.
- Your request must be received by Nov 30.
- You must return your absentee ballot before Dec 4.

If you choose to vote early by mailing an absentee ballot, you do not need to show or include any photo ID.
