AFFORDABLE CARE ACT Support Affordable Care Act, aka Obamacare?	No. <u>Supports lawsuit to end ACA</u> . Calls <u>Medicare for All insidious attack on liberty</u> .	Yes. Would "protect, improve, and build upon the Affordable Care Act."
CLIMATE CHANGE Is human-caused climate change a serious threat? Address as a top priority by taxing or limiting output of greenhouse gases?	No climate change position found. Her company previously lobbied for cap and trade when they'd likely have gotten contracts to administer it.	Yes. It "is not something that is coming, it is here. It is way past time for all of us to get serious." "Set goals for carbon reduction and robust climate standards for newly manufactured cars and infrastructure."
COURTS Pick Ruth Bader Ginsburg replacement before November election? See CEEP Supreme Court guide.	Before. "Our country's future is at stake and Trump has every right to pick a new justice before the election."	Wait. "The voices of the people that [Ginsburg] stood up for time and time again ought to be heard before there is a vote."
COVID-19 Support administration's response to coronavirus pandemic?	Yes. "Trump and his administration have taken the threat of COVID-19 seriously from the beginning." Senate and Justice Department cleared Loeffler of insider trading following early COVID briefings.	No. Both Trump and Georgia Governor Kemp have stumbled on pandemic response. "We need leadership that believes in science and will act with integrity."
COVID-19 Economic response to coronavirus pandemic?	Introduced bills to protect reopening businesses from liability if employees or customers are infected, to make stop-gap "short-term health plans a permanent solution," and to get U.S. medical supply companies to relocate from China to U.S.	Will better support "those who have been hit hardest by the pandemic working to fund unemployment and other systems," ensuring that small businesses are not left out of relief programs.
EDUCATION Public funding for private or for-profit schools?	Yes. Let states send federal funds for low- income students to both public and private schools.	No position found.
ELECTIONS Support Texas lawsuit to overturn election results in Georgia, Michigan, Pennsylvania and Wisconsin	Supports. "We fully support President Trump's legal recourses and Attorney General Paxton's lawsuit any illegal vote submitted cannot be counted."	Opposes. "Donald Trump and @KLoeffler are trying to overturn a free and fair election and undo the will of Georgia voters."
ENVIRONMENT Tighten or loosen environmental regulations?	Unclear, but general anti-regulatory stance. Wants to "look at what we're doing with regard to the economy and the environment collectively."	Tighten. "Environmental justice is on the ballot." Nothing is "more important than honoring and protecting the only home we've been blessed with."

FINANCIAL REGULATION Tighten or loosen regulation of banks and credit card companies?	Loosen. Co-sponsored bills to eliminate "unnecessary" regulations, and to delay banking regulations. "Phase out all federal regulations that have been waived during the COVID-19 crisis."	No position found.
GUNS Enact more restrictive legislation on guns?	No. <u>"Strong Second Amendment supporter."</u> Sponsored <u>bill</u> barring national firearm database.	Yes. "The answer to America's gun violence isn't to encourage masses of people to carry guns."
IMMIGRATION Expand border walls? Reduce immigration?	Yes. <u>Co-sponsored Asylum Abuse Reduction</u> <u>Act. Undocumented should not get free</u> <u>health care</u> .	No. Immigration is "desperately broken." Cites Jesus as an "undocumented immigrant."
IMMIGRATION Create path to citizenship for 11 million undocumented residents, including DACA participants, or "dreamers" brought to the U.S. as children?	No. Wants to "hold illegal immigrants accountable." Co-sponsored bills to stop states from issuing driver's licenses to undocumented immigrants and set fines for aliens in the U.S. improperly.	Yes. <u>"People need a dignified path to citizenship."</u> About DACA, <u>"You have no right to celebrate the dream if you will not liberate the dreamers."</u>
IMPEACHMENT Support calling witnesses and indicting Trump on impeachment charges?	No. "This impeachment sham is an attack on what was a free and fair election." Advertises her "100% Trump voting record [as] the most conservative senator in America."	No position found.
LABOR Support "right to work" laws, barring unions from mandating dues?	Yes. <u>Co-sponsored National Right-to-Work</u> <u>Act</u> , establishing right to work on a national basis.	No. Supports "pay equity" with "honest wages, protected retirement, and fair overtime compensation." Endorsed by Georgia AFL-CIO.
LEGAL ABORTION Keep legal or ban?	Ban. "Unapologetically pro-life." Has co- sponsored "four bills to protect the unborn."	Legal. Supports "a woman's right to choose, a decision between her and her doctor."
LGBTQ RIGHTS Protect against discrimination based on sexual orientation?	Not if it interferes with religious faith. "People of faith should be protected."	Yes. Will "protect members of the LGBTQ+ community from housing, financial, and employment discrimination."
MARIJUANA Legal or ban?	Ban. Is "concerned about the negative effects that legalizing marijuana would have."	Legal. Wants to <u>decriminalize marijuana</u> .
MINIMUM WAGE Raise federal minimum from \$7.25 per hour?	No position found.	Yes. \$7.25 an hour "is not a living wage." Will "fight to raise the minimum to a livable wage."
PLANNED PARENTHOOD Allow receiving public funds for non-abortion-related health care?	No. Called for investigating Planned Parenthood for receiving taxpayer funds under the Paycheck Protection Program.	Yes. Opposes <u>"all partisan attacks defunding health care providers like Planned Parenthood."</u>
POLICE/COMMUNITY Restrict police use of force and increase public oversight?	No. Co-sponsored resolutions supporting "Back the Blue" and opposing calls to defund. Critics failing "to support law enforcement at a time when they need it most."	Yes. Wants increased accountability and bias training and a uniform standard for the use of force. Does not support defunding.
STUDENT FINANCIAL AID Support lower interest or forgiveness on student loans?	No position found.	Yes. Work to fully fund Pell Grants and strengthen loan forgiveness programs to ensure graduates can pay their loans.
VOTING RULES Support stricter ID requirements and other rules on voting?	Yes. Introduced bill to raise penalties for voter fraud and illegal ballot harvesting.	No. Supports restoring oversight provisions of Voting Rights Act, which made voting restrictions harder to enact.
